# Gram Sabha

- Gram Sabhas are constitutionally mandated platform for participatory governance at the Panchayat level
- This platform is used for discussions relating to all programmes and schemes aimed at poverty reduction and local development.
- Gram Sabha provides a space for people to participate in the decision making process at the local level
- Gram Sabha is considered as the base of decentralized democracy

As per the MoPR guidelines for GPDP, Gram Sabha will be used as a site of participation and validation for the all the decisions made for GPDP

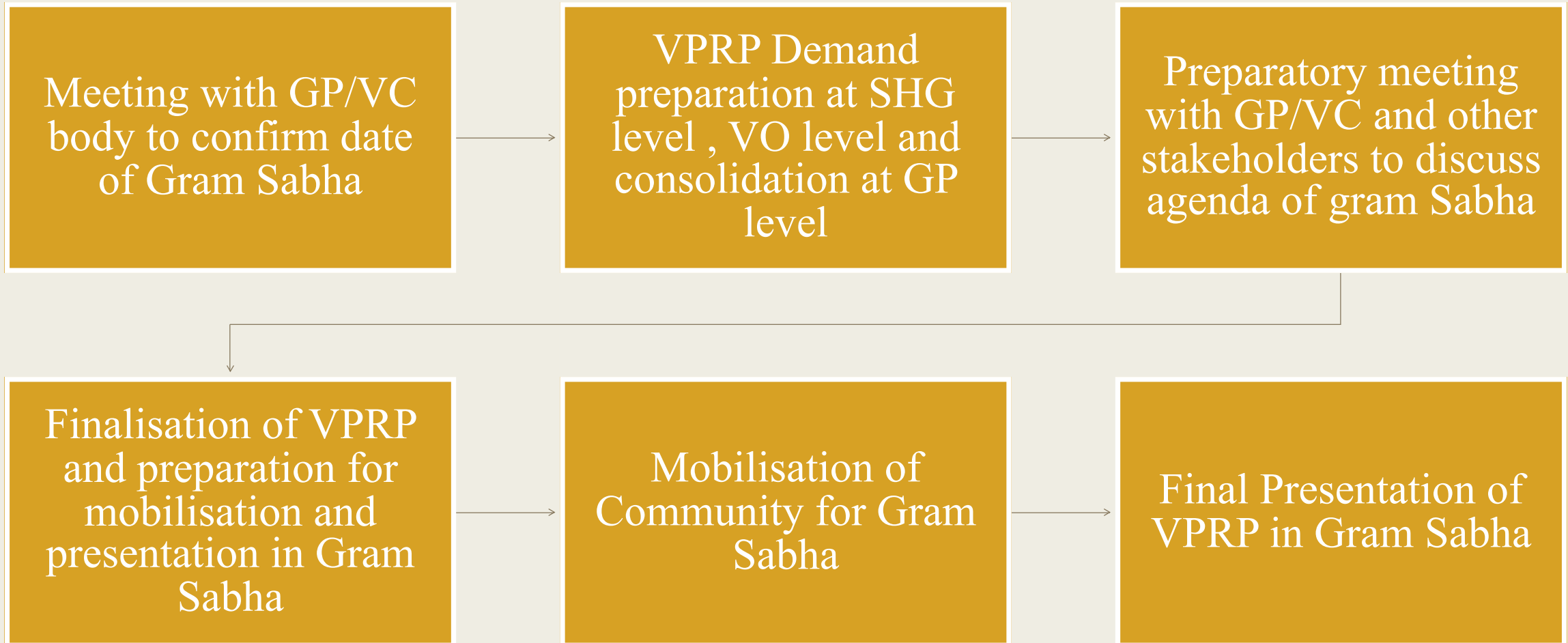


Special Gram Sabhas are conducted over the course of three months starting from October 2<sup>nd</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup>

SHG members can utilize various methods of performance arts such as skits, street plays, dramas etc. to spread awareness about the relevance of Gram Sabha to a larger audience

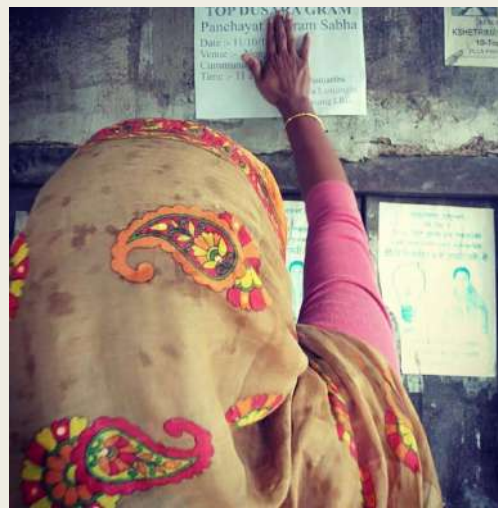


Songs and use of musical instruments like drums can also be an effective mobilisation technique
