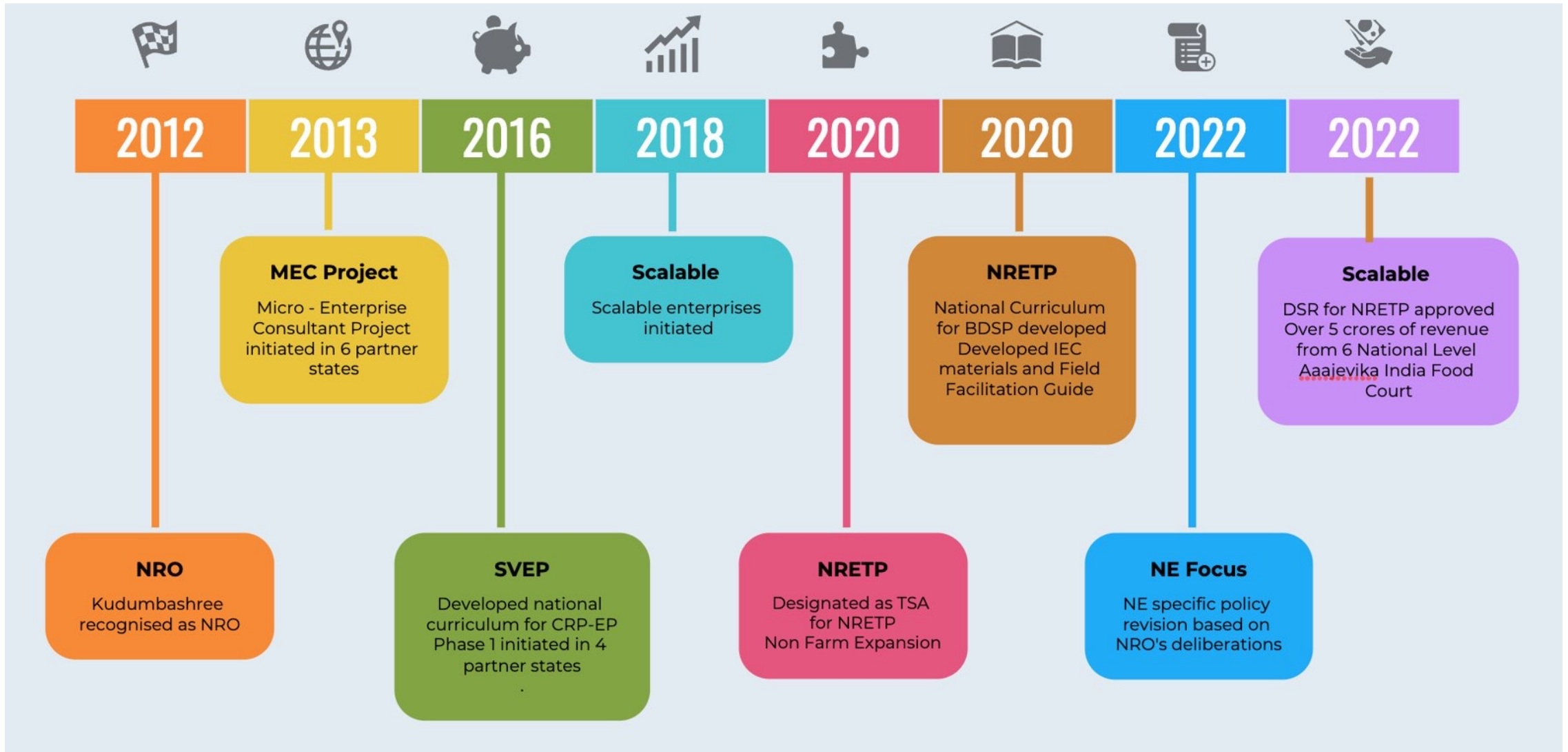

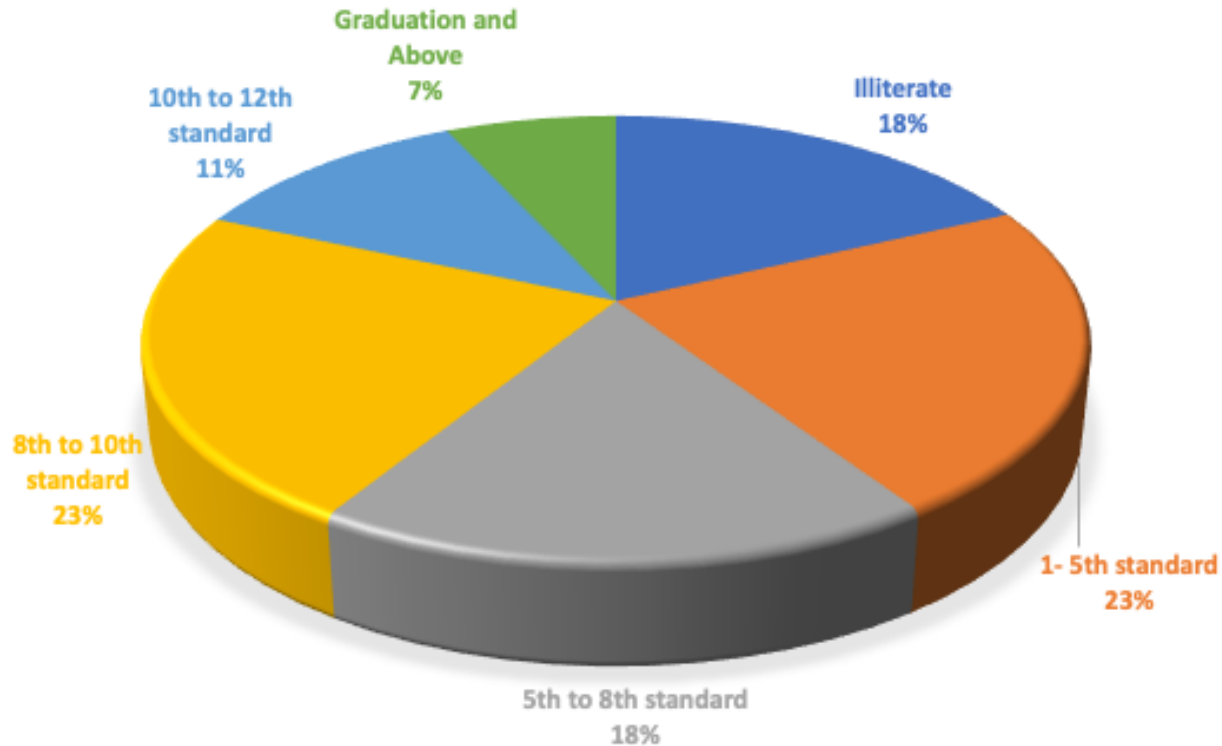

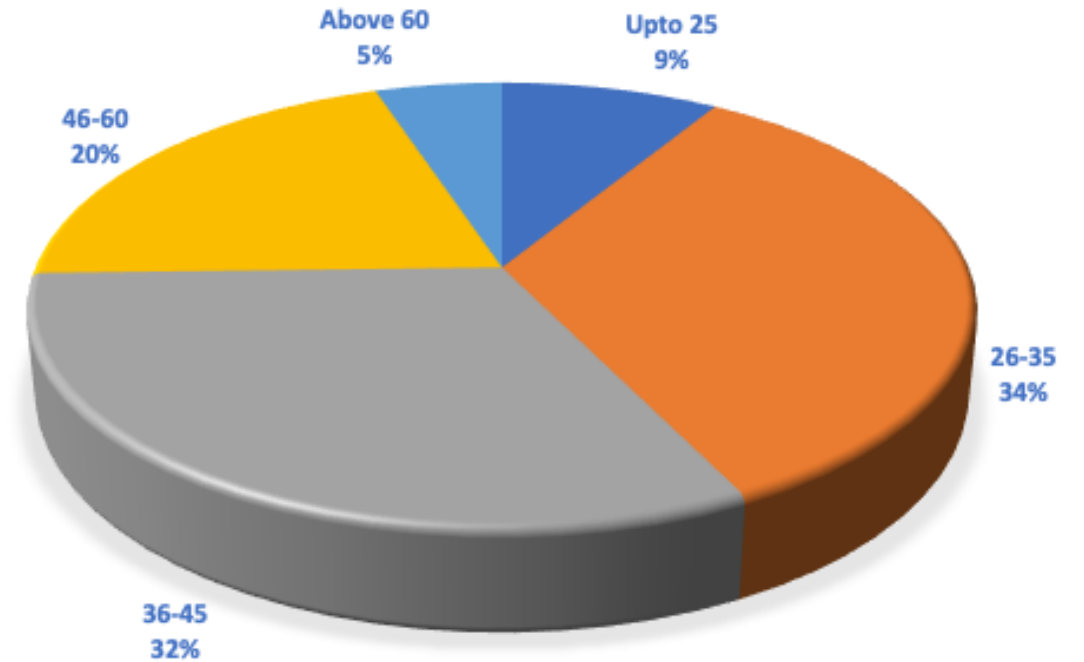
Achievement by Gender and Social Category

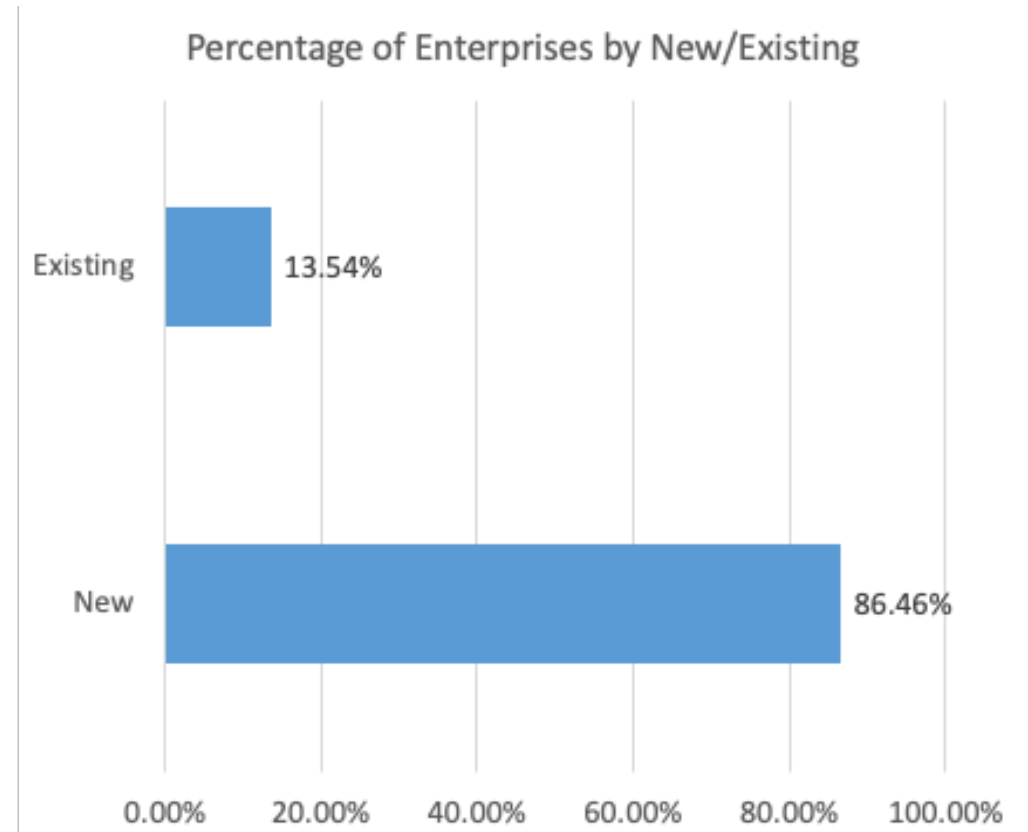

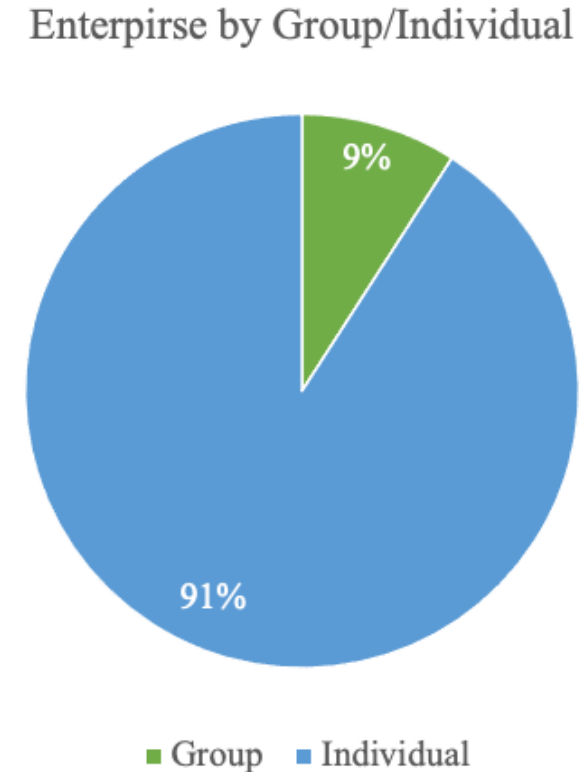

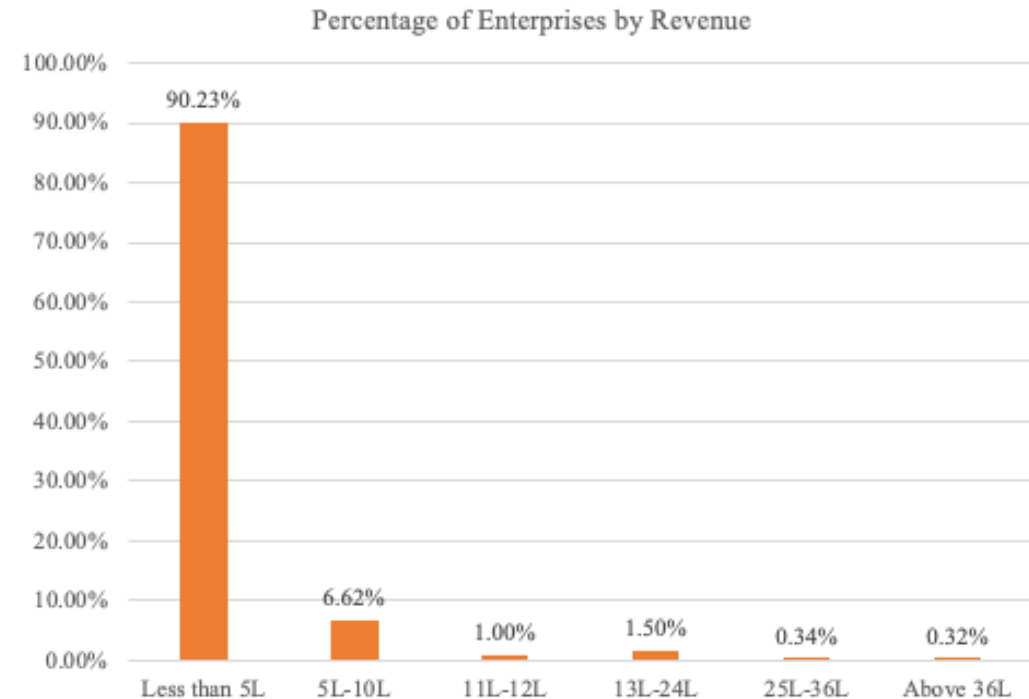
